The best time to visit Argentina is in spring (September through November), when the jacarandas are in bloom and temperatures are blissfully cool, and in fall (March through May). From mighty Iguazú Falls in the subtropical north to the thunderous, crackling advance of the Perito Moreno Glacier in the south, the country boasts some of the Andes' highest peaks, several of which top 6000m near Mendoza and San Juan. Rio de Janeiro is really quite moderate all year round. From the world-famous beaches of Copacabana and Ipanema to the tops of scenic outlooks of Corcovado and Pão de Açúcar to the dance halls, bars and open-air cafes that proliferate the city, this idea of paradise has enchanted visitors for centuries.
