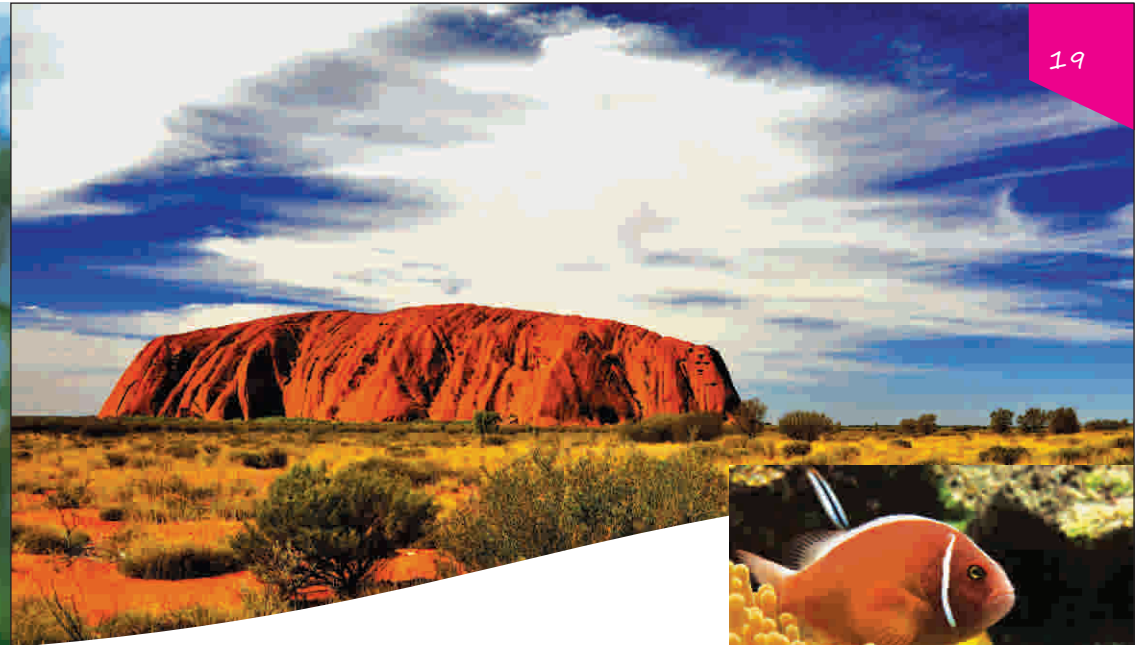

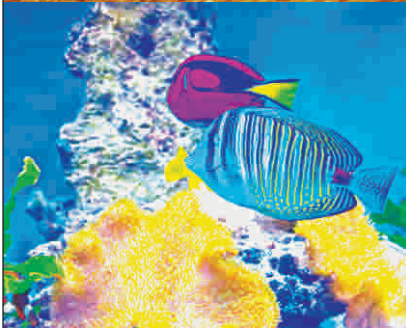

Spring (Sep-Nov) and Autumn (Mar-May) are ideal times in which to visit Perth.
