The peak tourist season is from June to August, this is the best time to go trekking on the Inca Trail to Machu Picchu, or climbing, hiking and mountain biking elsewhere. Many of the major fiestas, such as La Virgen de la Candelaria, Carnaval and Semana Santa, occur in the wettest months. Visit the glorious Inca citadel of Machu Picchu.. Walk through the dusted remnants of a vast ancient city at Chan Chan. Fly over the puzzling geoglyphs etched into the arid earth at Nazca. Or venture into the rugged wilds that hem the stalwart fortress of Kuelap. Lima's great museums, with priceless ceramics, gold and some of the finest textiles in the world, reveal in full detail the sophistication, skill and passion of these lost civilizations.
