Sweden is at its best during summer and autumn late May to September. Finland - The tourist season is from early June to late August. Norway - The best time is from mid-June to mid-August. North of the Arctic Circle, the true midnight sun is visible at least one day a year, and at Nordkapp it stays out from 13 May to 29 July. Denmark - Late June, July and August are high season. Travel through some of Europe's most stylish capitals and be wowed by some of the world's biggest fjords.
