The best time to visit Sana is from October to February. The best time to visit Oman is between November and mid-March, when the cooler air brings the mountain scenery sharply into focus and daytime temperatures average 25°C. Admire the view over Wadi Dhar and Dar al-Hajjar. Move onto the historical village of Thula where the houses are stone-built high-rise structures, their facades embellished with decorations and molded qamariyas decorated with pieces of marbles or stained glass. Oman is pristine and mystical. A full-day trip acquaints you with the history of Oman and its famous fortresses in Nizwa (the ancient capital of Oman), Bahla (a mystical village under UNESCO protection) and Jabrin.
